Balbina Kamawaiakea Ball, 89, formerly of Griffin, died Wednesday, February 17, 2021 at her son's home in Lancaster, CA.

Born in Honolulu, HI, December 29, 1931, Balbina was the daughter of the late Louis Gomes Branco and Loretta Kamawaiakea Jones. She was a US Air Force Veteran and was retired from the Federal Aviation Administration where she served as a computer operator for over 33 years. Additionally, she was a Pearl Harbor survivor.
