Catherine Ann Callan Pursley, 84, of Griffin, died Thursday, March 6, 2025, at The Woods Senior Care.

Born in Philadelphia, PA, June 4, 1940, a daughter of the late John Patrick and Isabelle Scott Callan. Ms. Pursley was a graduate of Georgia State College for Women where she earned a bachelor's degree in history and later graduated from West Georgia College, where she earned a master's degree in education.

She retired from Griffin High School where she taught Gifted and Honors students AP and World History. She formerly led the Academic Team and was also formerly a Cheerleading Coach. She was Star Teacher seven times.

Ms. Pursley was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by sisters, Gloria and Patricia Callan.
