



Cecil Lemuel Lawrence

September 16, 1942 - July 15, 2023

Cecil Lemuel Lawrence, 80, of Temple, husband of Patricia Annette Chapman Lawrence, died Saturday, July 15, 2023, at his home.

Born in Birmingham, AL, on September 16, 1942, he was the son of the late M.L. and Cora Smith Lawrence. He was known for a strong work ethic and began his career as a plumber. He later started in construction, establishing Cecil Lawrence, Inc. and the Lawrence Group, where he was very successful in both commercial and residential properties. His company would later grow to include a total of 19 funeral homes and cemeteries throughout Tennessee, Alabama, and Georgia. Until his death he played an active role as President of the company. His saying was, "I hope I'm working on the biggest deal of my life the day I die."

Surviving in addition to his wife of sixty-three years are three sons, Dale Lawrence and wife, Rita, Larry Lawrence and wife, Connie, and Michael "Mike" Lawrence and wife, Phylline; a daughter, Carol Lawrence, all of Temple; eleven grandchildren; and ten great-grandchildren.
