Mr. Charles “Chuck” Bishop, age 87 of Thomaston, passed away Friday, January 26, 2018 at his home.

Mr. Bishop was born January 20, 1931 in Dayton, OH, son of the late Joseph & Mary Bishop. He was a veteran of the U.S. Marines where he played for the Marine Base Baseball Team in Cuba and continued to play baseball & softball as a civilian until the age of 75.
