Dennis Calvin "Flash" Terrell, 68, of Griffin, husband of Sheena Patrice Prewitt Terrell died Wednesday, September 8, 2021 at his home.

Born in Griffin, February 13, 1953, he was a son of the late Calvin Elmo and Winifred Elizabeth Shepherd Terrell. 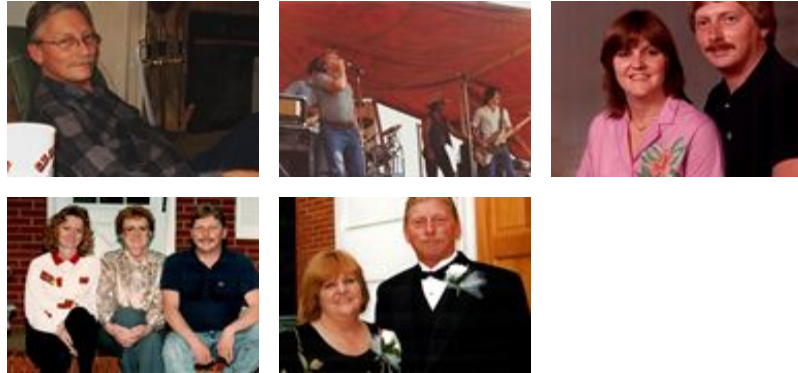
