Dennis E. Pharr of Ocala, FL passed away on Thursday, July 5, 2018.

He was born in Thomaston, GA on October 18, 1935 to Howard C. Pharr and Sarah Blount Pharr. He graduated from R. E. Lee High School in 1954. Upon graduation he joined the U.S. Navy followed by the U.S. Marines and retired from the Army after 23 years of service in Korea and Iraq. He attended Grady Radiology School and was a Rad Technologist for 52 years in Griffin, Newnan, Marietta and Jackson. Dennis coached Little League Baseball and football in Griffin for many years.

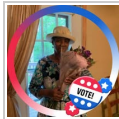
