Dru and I shared one love, our nursing profession and experiences. We met many of her nurse friends and became a part of their lives too.

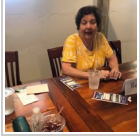
Age and frailties caught with us in the last few years so our correspondence and traveling became less and less.

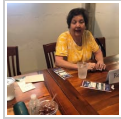
