



## Edith Lathene Cook Camp

December 5, 1931 - November 8, 2022

Edith Lathene Cook Camp, 90, of Griffin, wife of Charles Lee Camp, died Tuesday, November 8, 2022, at her home.

Born in Alpharetta, December 5, 1931, she was a daughter of the late Clarence Robert and Elizabeth Bertha Garrison Cook. Mrs. Camp was retired after thirty years of service from Cross Keys High School in Dekalb County, where she formerly served as lunchroom manager and retired as bookkeeper. She and her husband formerly owned and operated Avan Palms a permanent RV and small housing community in Bowling Green, FL. She was a master quilt maker and loved any sort of craft.

Mrs. Camp was a member of Carver Road Baptist Church, where she was a member of the Senior Adult Sunday School Class.

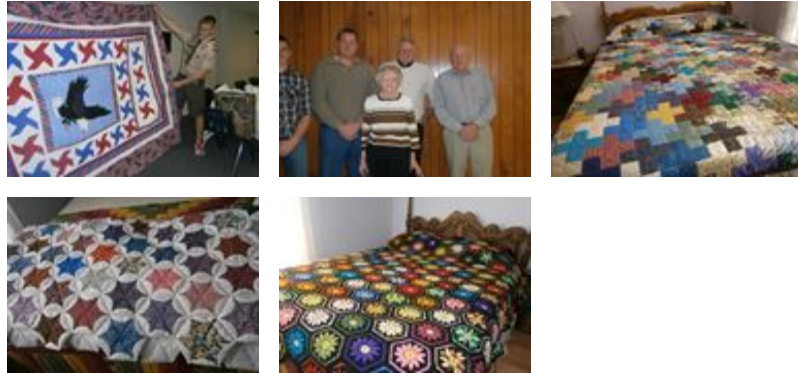
