



Elizabeth Ann "Beth" Williams Chappell

March 21, 1955 - August 22, 2021

Beth Chappell, of Hamilton, GA, passed away on Sunday evening, August 22nd. She was a native of Selma, Alabama. A graduate of Atlanta Christian College (now Point University) and East Tennessee State University. She married Paul W. Chappell of Hampton, GA in 1978 and they had 43 years together. She is survived by her husband and three children: her daughter Laura Gentilello and her husband Eric with grandchildren Everett and Dorothy; Marshall Chappell, her son; and her daughter Emily Tutt and her husband Brandon, with grandchildren Zelda and Naomi, who is expected to join the family on December 5th of this year. She is also survived by her older sister Alice Williams of Selma, AL, as well as several nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her parents, Marshall and Gloria Williams of Selma, her younger sister Susan Dewitt of Selma, AL and her in-laws John and Helen Chappell of Hampton, GA.

Beth spent her professional career as a schoolteacher in Georgia. The early years in Bartow County and the later years in Meriwether County and Harris County. As a lifetime member of the Christian Church she spent the last 22 years as a member of Northside Christian Church in Columbus, GA. Her faith and service and legacy spent in serving Jesus Christ will remain as an example to us all. She made it very clear before she passed on from this world that her heart was at peace and her true home is in heaven.

All services in her memory will be held at Northside Christian Church, 9801 Whitesville Rd, Fortson, GA 31808. Visitation will be Friday, August 27 from 5-8pm. The Funeral Service will be Saturday, August 28 at 11am. There will be no graveside service at this time.
