



## Franklin Pierce Lindsey III

May 16, 1949 - December 20, 2023

Mr. Franklin Pierce Lindsey III, 74, passed away at home on December 20, 2023.

He was born in Griffin, Ga., on May 16, 1949, the son of the late Franklin Pierce Lindsey, Jr. and Edith Alling Dale Lindsey.
