



Jacqueline Hackle "Jackie" Smith

Jacqueline Hackle "Jackie" Smith, 97, of Barnesville, formerly of Stone Mountain, widow of Raymond Lee Smith, died Thursday, April 15, 2021 at Wellstar Spalding Regional Hospital.

Born in Nashville, GA, August 25, 1923, she was a daughter of the late Edward Carlton and Jabe Johnson Hackle. She formerly served as Office Manager for Pope Chevrolet for many years before retiring. Mrs. Smith was a member of Electa Chapter 6 Order of the Eastern Star and was also a dual member of Stone Mountain Order of the Eastern Star Chapter 205. Had Mrs. Smith lived until her birthday she would have been a member of the Electa Chapter for 80 years. She had served the Chapter as Matron several times and was currently serving as Marshall of the Chapter. She was a former District Grand Deputy, Grand Representative and an Elected Grand Trustee of the Order of the Eastern Star and had also served as a Rainbow Board Member, Rainbow Mother Advisor and Rainbow State Mother Advisor. She was an avid Atlanta Braves fan and was a season ticket holder for many, many years.

Mrs. Smith was a member of First Baptist Church of Stone Mountain where she had formerly been very involved in the Young at Heart.

She was preceded in death by her daughter, Deborah Smith Lloyd; and a sister, Dorothy Woodward.

Survivors include a sister, Katherine Hackle Lapenna and husband Robert of Euless, TX; and numerous nieces, nephews, great-nieces and great-nephews.
