Mrs. Janice Ann Bentley Peek, age 77, life-long resident of Louvale, GA., passed away Sunday, September 7, 2025 at Piedmont Midtown Hospital in Columbus.

Janice was born December 25, 1947 in Columbus, GA. She was the daughter of the late R.M. "Reese" Bentley and Mary Shierling Bentley. 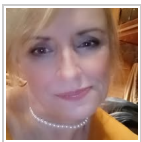
