



## Jean McDaniel Black

August 10, 1925 - September 14, 2022

Mrs. Jean McDaniel Black of Griffin, GA, passed away September 14, 2022, at Brightmoor Senior Living in Griffin, GA. She was born August 10, 1925, in Alamo, GA to the late William Richmond McDaniel and the late Ellen Wade McDaniel.

Mrs. Black was preceded in death by her husband Dr. Grady Emmet Black, her daughter Nancy Elizabeth Black and her son Dr. James Robert Black. Also preceding her in death were her parents, her brothers, William Wade McDaniel and Joseph Frederick McDaniel and sisters, Margaret McDaniel Carlisle and Sarah McDaniel Carlson.

Jean graduated from Wheeler County High School, attended Middle Georgia College and was a graduate of the University Hospital School of Nursing in Augusta, GA. After graduation, she worked as a nurse at Oliver General Hospital and University Hospital in Augusta.

She was married for 55 years to her late husband, Dr. Grady Black. They moved to Griffin in 1950 where Dr. Black set up his pediatric medical practice. They loved living in Griffin and chose to raise their 4 children there. They enjoyed traveling, seeing many beautiful and interesting places, including to Egypt and the Holy Lands, Ireland, Great Britain, Mexico, many places in the United States and countless memorable family vacations.

Jean also enjoyed reading, volunteer work, gardening and playing bridge with lifelong friends. Her greatest joy, though, was the time she spent with her family.

She was a longtime and active member of the Griffin (South Hill Street) Church of Christ, member and former president of the Dogwood Garden Club, member of the Daughters of the American Revolution and the Griffin Historical Society. She was a former member of the Utility Club of Griffin and the Spalding County Medical Auxiliary.
