Jeanette Hatcher, 83, of Decatur, died Monday, April 1, 2024, at Eternal Hope Hospice.

Born in Arlington, GA, August 27, 1940, she was a daughter of the late Harvey Thomas and Myrtle Adams Hatcher. A graduate Arlington High School, Miss Hatcher received a BS Degree in Education at Georgia Southern College and a MS in Education from The University of Tennessee.
