Jimmy Lee Briscoe, 74, of Williamson, passed away Wednesday, December 17, 2025, at his home. He was the beloved husband of Mary Ann Harmon Briscoe, with whom he shared 57 years of marriage. 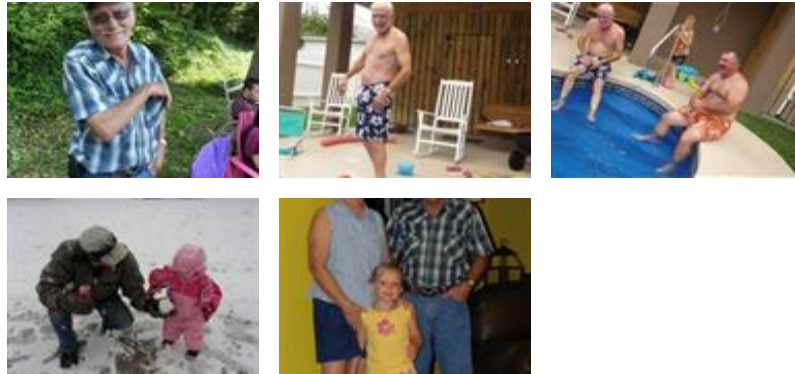
