



Dr. Jose Roberto Oviedo

July 20, 1934 - May 28, 2024

Dr. José Roberto Oviedo, 89, of Griffin, passed away the morning of Tuesday, May 28, 2024, at the Hope Center in Fayetteville, GA.

Roberto, the youngest of eight children, was born in Tegucigalpa, Honduras in 1934 to Enriqueta Cubas Oviedo and Santiago Oviedo. After earning his medical degree in his home country, he completed his residency in anesthesia at the Medical College of Virginia, now Virginia Commonwealth University in Richmond, VA.

During the Vietnam War, he served as a physician in the United States Navy stationed in Da Nang, and upon completion of his service, he was honorably discharged with the rank of Lieutenant Commander. Settling in Griffin, Georgia, Roberto devoted three decades of his life to his career as an anesthesiologist at Griffin Spalding County Hospital. Beyond his professional endeavors, he embraced life's pleasures, finding joy in fine dining, exploring the world through travel, and in the beauty of classical music and art.

He is survived by four daughters: Rita María Orellana of Tegucigalpa, Honduras, Carmen Oviedo (Matt Miller) of Arlington, Virginia, Marcia Oviedo of Norcross, GA, and Gabriella Oviedo of Atlanta, GA; as well as a brother, Dr. Raúl Oviedo (Marian) of Elkton, VA. Grandchildren include Karla, Carlos and Gabriela Orellana and Isabel and Gabriel Miller.
