Sarah Margaret Cook Moore (Margaret) died Friday, March 14, 2025, at age 97 at The Hope House in Giffin, GA.

Margaret was born in High Point, NC, November 6, 1927, to Oscar Glenn Cook and Sarah Agnes Cook. She attended elementary school in Clayton County, GA, graduated with a High School Diploma from Gordon Military College in 1944, and later attended post-graduate studies at Brenau College in Gainesville, GA.

Margaret served as a Civilian Aircraft Observer during WW2 in Griffin. She was a very avid golfer, member of the Griffin Ladies' Golf Association, and earned the title of Griffin City Ladies' Champion for several years. Her love of golf and competitive spirit, combined with her love of travel, took her to many locations throughout the state, the nation, and several countries.

She was involved with the Utility Club and Kiwanis Club, loved gardening, playing bridge, and attending performing arts.

Margaret was a long-time member of the First United Methodist Church, choir member, and she was instrumental in organizing fellow church members to design and craft Chrismon ornaments for the church Christmas tree.

She is survived by her three children, Lou Oxford, Tom Moore and Kevin Moore; 6 grandchildren; and 4 great-grandchildren.

A memorial service will be conducted Wednesday, March 19, 2025, at 2:00 PM from the Chapel of Haisten McCullough Funeral Home with Reverend Debby Stikes officiating. Private burial will be at the Memorial Garden of Griffin

First United Methodist Church.

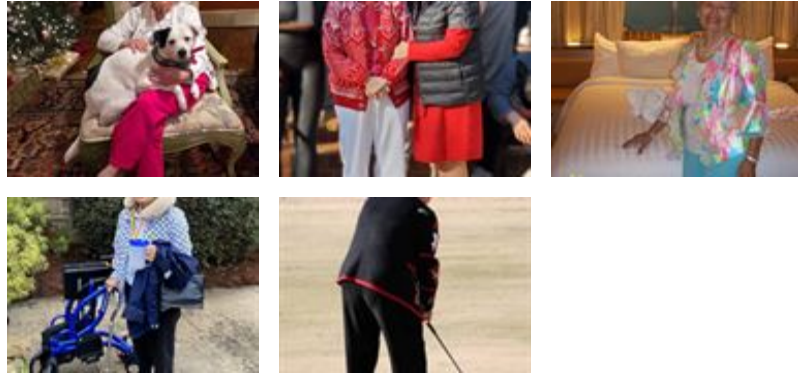
