Whenever I left him alone for even the shortest time, even when running to the bathroom, he wasted absolutely no time pulling the phone down onto the floor and somehow speed dialing the Ready Pack Shipping Office. Of all the numbers we had saved on speed dial, he ALWAYS chose that one. If Marty was there, he’d answer and although Roddy spoke no actual words, Marty would always hold a full conversation with him. I’d come back into the room and Roddy would be blabbing gibberish until his cheeks turned pink. His smile wide, drool down his chin, head thrown back while in a full conversation about anything from possibly the weather, fishing, to who knows what else. No matter how many times that child found that phone, Marty always made time to shoot the baby talk breeze with him.

I, like many others will miss Marty. I understand the amount of pain he experienced and find some comfort in knowing that that is no more. I also find comfort in knowing that through both sickness and in health, Marty lives his life HIS WAY. Not many of us can say that. He was steadfast in his ways and I do believe that if nothing else, he was happy knowing that until the very end, he did it his way.
