Mildred Osburn Wallace, 89, of Griffin, widow of Walter Fred Wallace died Saturday, April 3, 2021 at her home.

Born in Selma, AL, July 1, 1931, she was the daughter of the late Arthur Marvin and Marie Lackey Osburn. Mrs. Wallace was a lifelong banker, having retired from both First Union and United Bank.
