Mr. Paul Harold Moore, Sr. of Griffin, GA passed away Wednesday, October 13, 2021.

Paul was born in Byron, GA. He was a 1962 graduate of Athens High School, graduated from the University of Georgia School of Pharmacy in June, 1967 and a week after graduating married fellow pharmacy graduate, Jean Huckabee. Following his school ROTC Air Force commitment, he and his wife went to Tyndall Air Force Base, Wheelus Air Force Base and Blytheville Air Force Base. During this time, they welcomed two sons, Paul, Jr. and Kenneth Michael. After Paul's time in the military, he began his search for a job in retail pharmacy. In 1972 God led him to Griffin, GA and Richard Hobbs at Hobbs Pharmacy. He later purchased Hobbs Pharmacy and Gifts and retired in 2011. His joy came from serving others. He loved his Lord, his church through work and missions, his customers and his employees.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Robert & Jeanette Moore, brother, Robert Moore and sister, Janice Moore.
