Bob was born on August 24, 1939, in Atlanta, Georgia. He joined the United States Marines in 1957 and served his country honorably for four years. His grandchildren were his life's delight, and he spent countless hours creating memories with them. From tractor and wagon rides to tire swinging and playing with the cuckoo clock, he was always there, filling their lives with joy and love. The memories they created with him will be forever cherished.

With a passion for the United States Marines, Bob became the founder of the Steven W. Pless Chapter 1196 Marine Corps League in Griffin, Georgia, named in honor of his best friend and Medal of Honor recipient, Steven Pless.

Throughout his 85 years, Bob was a devoted believer in Jesus Christ. His unwavering belief in our Lord and Savior was a pillar of strength, not only to himself but to those around him. His life is a testament to Psalm 128:2: "You shall eat the fruit of the labor of your hands; you shall be blessed, and it shall be well with you."

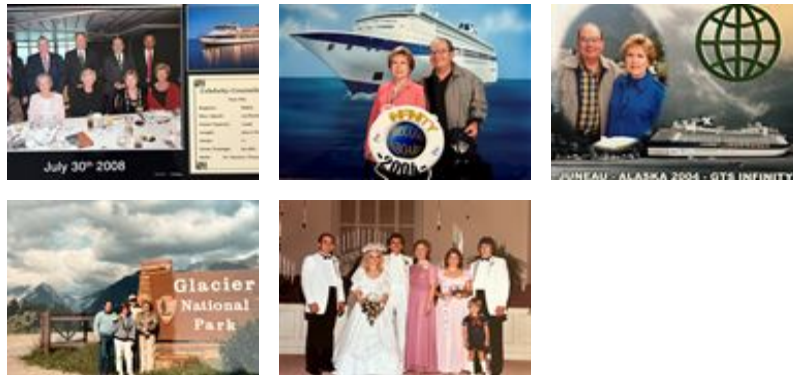

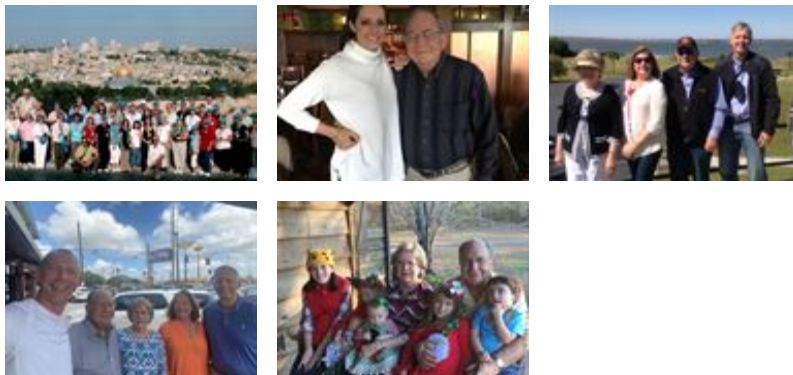
