Mr. Russell Marvin Moody, age 94 of Griffin, passed away Sunday, June 3, 2018 at his home.

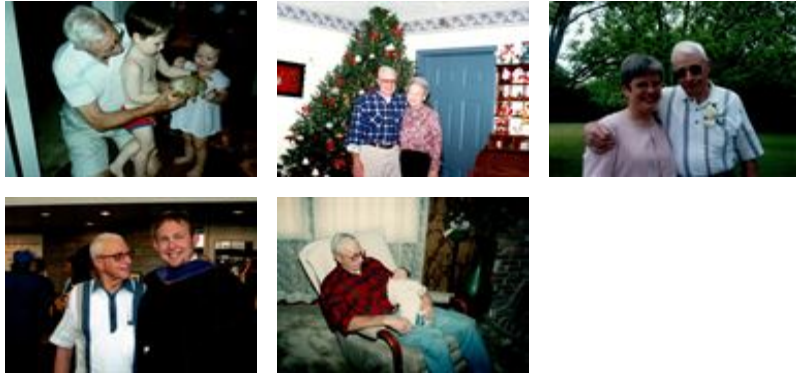
