Thomas Franklin "Frank" Brooks, Sr., 87, of Brooks, husband of Shirley Ann Meeks Brooks, died Thursday, April 24, 2025, at his home.

Born in Brooks, August 3, 1937, he was a son of the late Carl Francis and Ruby Hardy Brooks. Mr. Brooks was retired after twenty years of service from the US Air Force, where he served as an Aircraft Electrician, obtaining the rank of Technical Sergeant. He served two tours in Vietnam, receiving numerous medals for his service to his country. He later retired from Norfolk Southern after twenty-three years, where he served as a Diesel Electrician. Mr. Brooks was a private family man and enjoyed working around his home and tinkering with cars.

He was a member of Brooks United Methodist Church.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a brother, Carl Brooks.
