William Scott Nunnally, 46, of Jonesboro passed away suddenly at his parents' home Thursday, May 19, 2022.

Born in Austell, June 6, 1975, he was the son of Reverend Willam Duke and Joyce Ann Hayes Nunnally. Scott was a 1993 graduate of Jonesboro High School where he was listed in Who's Who Among American High School Students all four years. Scott attended Georgia Southern University. He was formerly a longtime employee of Dover Cylinder Head Company and worked for many years with Allied Motor Parts in East Point. He recently began working with Caterpillar, Inc. in Griffin. Scott was formerly an avid fisherman and hunter. While growing up he and his family enjoyed their summers camping and spending time at Lake Hartwell where he learned to ski. He loved Florida Gator Football.

Scott's dad, being a Baptist Pastor, allowed Scott to meet many friends and enjoy life as a young man taking part in many youth church activities that brought him much joy. 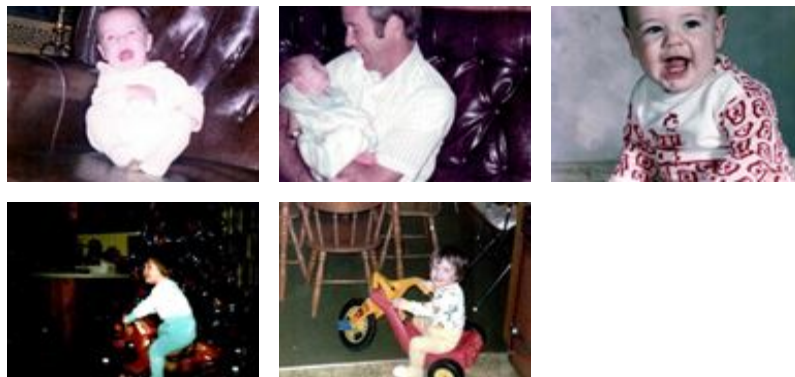
